



Chandelier Lifting

Chandelier lifting is the act of lifting two independently slung loads at different levels in a single lift.

Chandelier lifts are unsafe for a number of reasons, including:

- Slinger working below a suspended load when detaching the lowest load.
- Increased risk of separate loads snagging during the lift.
- Load becoming unbalanced during the lift.

Chandelier Lifting is prohibited on all Morgan Sindall Construction Projects.

Actions:

- Ensure this SHE Alert is communicated to all contractors undertaking lifting operations on Morgan Sindall Construction's projects.
- During SHE Pre-start Meetings discuss the prohibition of chandelier lifting, highlighting the requirement in Section 17.11 of Creating a Safe and Sustainable Environment (CASSE) Document.
