



Supply Chain - Hot Works Training

In May 2023 we communicated to our supply chain partners regarding changes to fire safety arrangements detailed in the tenth edition of the Joint Code of Practice for Fire Prevention on Construction Sites (JCOP).

A key reason for this communication was to inform our supply chain of the requirement for all persons undertaking hot work activities to have received formal hot works training, and that we as Morgan Sindall were implementing a grace period that would be in place until **31st December 2023**.

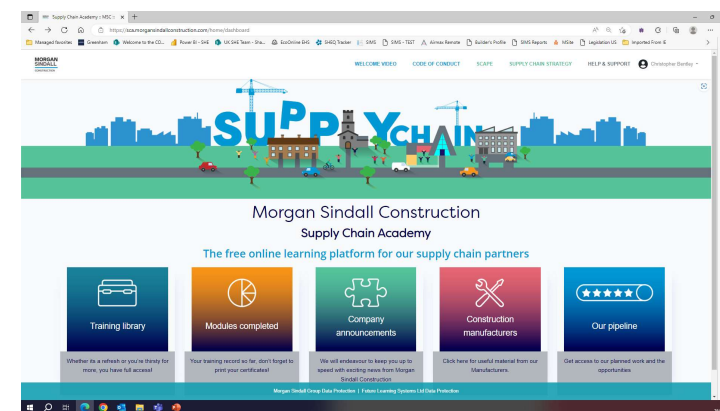
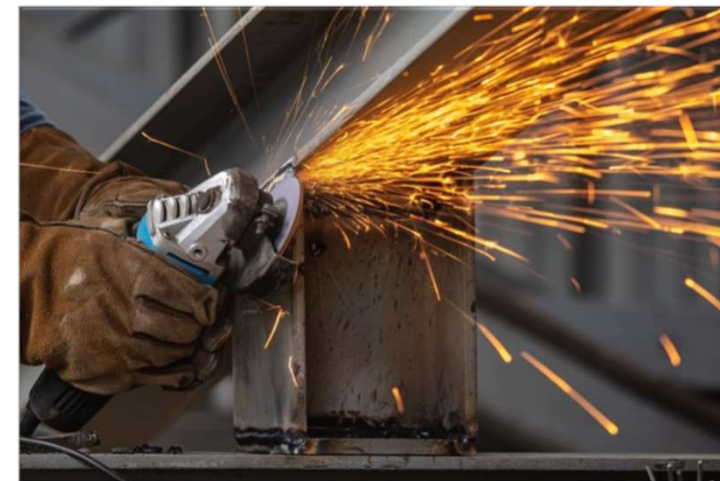
From 1st January 2024, hot work permits will not be issued to any supply chain operative that cannot provide evidence of hot works training.

To support our supply chain in obtaining this training, Morgan Sindall have developed a short training module for those who undertake hot works. This can be accessed free of charge on the Morgan Sindall Supply Chain Academy.
