Vacuum Slab Lifter

The movement and placing of slabs on site is a manual handling risk due to their weight and size.

Mechanical means should be used whenever possible.

The vacuum slab lifter is an option which eliminates the manual handling risk associated with lifting slabs by offering a fast and reliable method for laying slabs safely.

The lifter works by dipping the vacuum attachment in a shallow container of water then onto the slab to provide sufficient grip allowing the slab to be lifted and placed
